Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Why are open container laws important for traffic safety?

Open container laws help prevent *active consumption* of alcohol in vehicles—a major risk factor for impaired driving. By clearly prohibiting the use or easy access to intoxicating substances while driving, these laws provide officers with a simple, proactive tool to stop dangerous behavior *before* it results in a crash.

2. Do open container laws really reduce impaired driving?

Yes. States with strong alcohol open container laws have lower rates of impaired-driving crashes, according to federal data. However, the effectiveness of these laws is often tied to active enforcement, with research showing that enforcement of open container laws is underutilized.
